EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-07

HEARINGS BEFORE THE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE AND COMPLIANCE DATES FOR CODE COMPLIANCE, BUILDING, AND FIRE INSPECTIONS

On March 13, 2020 a State of Emergency was declared in the City of Coral Springs relating to the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19").

Pursuant to Section 252.46, *Florida Statutes* and Chapter 19 of the Code of the City of Coral Springs, the City has the power to issue emergency orders with the force of law. The City Manager has expressly been authorized to issue Emergency Orders.

All hearings, except hearings for health and safety violations, set before a Special Magistrate appointed by the City of Coral Springs are hereby cancelled. All Code Compliance, Building, and Fire cases cancelled pursuant to this Emergency Order shall be rescheduled for no sooner than ninety (90) days from the date of this Order.

All unexpired compliance dates as of the date of the declared State of Emergency, except for health and safety violations, provided for by any Final Order for any Code Compliance, Building Department, or Fire Inspection case are hereby extended ninety (90) calendar days.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
