

## CITY OF DORAL EMERGENCY ORDER No. 2020-07

## ALLOWING ONLY TEMPORARY PARKING ON MAIN STREET TO SUPPORT ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES

WHEREAS, March 26, 2020 the City of Doral issued "Safer at Home Emergency Order 2020-01.

WHEREAS, under Section 1.04 of the City Charter, the Mayor and City Council have the broadest exercise of home rule powers permitted under the Constitution and laws of the State.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has issued various Emergency Orders curtailing large public gatherings; temporarily closing non-essential commercial establishments and identifying essential commercial establishments that can remain open which has been applicable to and enforced by Doral; and

WHEREAS, in order to support essential businesses located on Main street (from 87<sup>th</sup> avenue to 84<sup>th</sup> avenue on NW 53<sup>rd</sup> street) temporary signage designating the parking spaces as temporary parking to be used for loading and pick ups shall be permitted during the State of Emergency.

WHEREAS, during the State of Emergency businesses located on Main Street shall be permitted to enforce the temporary parking requirements imposed by this emergency order.



**NOW THEREFORE**, Pursuant to the Section 1.04 of the City Charter it is hereby ordered that the parking spaces shall be used for temporary parking (30 Minutes) to allow for customers to pick up food from the essential businesses.

Section 1. Only Temporary Parking on Main Street Only temporary parking shall be permitted on Main street.

Section 2. <u>Businesses May enforce Temporary Parking Requirements</u>

Businesses located on Main Street may install signs identifying the parking as temporary and enforce the parking requirements.

The Emergency measures that have been ordered and promulgated above effective are extended through April 30, 2020.
