



**CITY OF DORAL EMERGENCY ORDER No. 2020-18  
Step-by-Step Plan for Re-Opening the City of Doral effective May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**

**WHEREAS**, on May 14, Governor DeSantis issued executive order 20-122, initiating Phase 1 of the Safe. Smart. Step-by-Step. Plan for Florida's Recovery to Miami Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County is preparing to re-open in a phased approach beginning on Monday, May 18; and

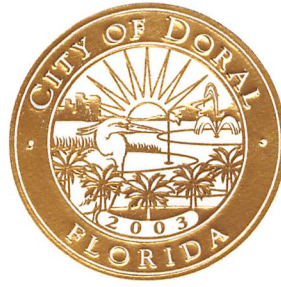
**WHEREAS**, the City of Doral will move to Phase 1 and implement the County's reopening strategy; and

**WHEREAS**, the path to re-opening Doral must promote business operation and economic recovery while maintaining focus on core safety principles: and

**WHEREAS**, The County has outlined guidance for each business to follow. The goal is a safer environment for workers and customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the guidance contained in the New Normal Guide was developed in close consultation with medical and industry experts and establishes stringent capacity and safety rules that must be followed; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recognizes the impact of economic hardship, but the risk of COVID-19 infection is still real for all Floridians. Therefore, each business should review the guidance that is relevant to their workplace, prepare a plan based on the guidance for their industry, and put it into action; and



**WHEREAS**, the City Charter grants to the Mayor in a State of Emergency the authority to take actions as may be necessary to protect the lives and health of the residents of the citizens of Doral.

**THEREFORE**, under the of Section 1.04 of the City Charter, and the home rule powers permitted under the Constitution and laws of the State, the City of Doral will open and implement the County's reopening plan.

**Section 1. Phase 1 Re-Opening.** The City adopts the guidance contained in the New Normal Guide for reopening businesses in Doral.

**Section 2. Businesses that will not open in Phase 1.** Gyms and fitness centers, bars, nightclubs, banquet halls, breweries, movie theaters, bowling alleys and businesses not specifically identified to be opened in Phase 1 are to remain closed.

**Section 3. Vacation rentals.** The prohibition on vacation rentals remains in effect.

**Section 4. Failure to comply.** Failure to comply with this Order shall constitute a misdemeanor subject to fines and imprisonment punishable as provided in F.S. §§ 775.082 and 775.083.

**The Emergency measures that have been ordered and promulgated above shall be effective commencing at 12.01 A.M on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**
