

## CITY OF DORAL EMERGENCY ORDER No. 2020-44

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2020 Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-122. initiating Phase 1 of the Safe. Smart. Step-by-Step. Plan for Florida's Recovery to Miami Dade County; and

WHEREAS, on March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 the City of Doral declared a local State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on July 7<sup>th</sup>,2020 Miami Dade County issued Amendment No. 2 to Miami Dade County Emergency order No 26-20; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter grants to the Mayor in a State of Emergency the authority to take actions as may be necessary to protect the lives and health of the citizens of Doral.

**THEREFORE**, under the of Section 1.04 of the City Charter, and the home rule powers permitted under the Constitution and laws of the State, the City of Doral will open and implement the County's reopening plan.

<u>Section 1. Extension of City of Doral Parks.</u> City of Doral Parks are open as per City of Doral Emergency Order 2020-27. The recreation centers will remain closed until further notice.

a. Organized or competitive play on courts and fields is prohibited, except singles and doubles tennis and racquetball play may be allowed in conformance with the Moving to A New Normal Handbook.



- b. No groups of 10 or more persons shall congregate in parks or recreational facilities. All persons, except family, shall observe social distancing, both within groups and with others.
- c. Only the following limited active uses are allowed: walking, jogging, hiking, skating, cycling, nature walks on trails and sports skills practice and drills in groups of less than ten. All activities must be performed in conformance with Moving to A New Normal Handbook.
- d. To ensure that social distancing is being maintained, parks staff may limit the number of persons using trails, paths, fields or courts, and may limit the time any persons spends on such trail, path, field or court.
- e. Organized or competitive play on courts and fields is prohibited, except singles and doubles tennis and racquetball.
- f. Park trails and walkways shall be one-way flow only, except where the existing configurations does not allow such flow. Where designated for one-way flow, persons shall only move in the designated direction.
- g. Facial coverings shall be worn, except children under the age of 2, persons who have trouble breathing due to chronic pre-existing condition, or persons engaged in strenuous physical activity.
- h. An attendant shall be provided for each restroom. Restrooms shall be cleaned no less than once every two hours with CDC approved products. Restroom shall be one person or one family at a time.



- i. Vehicle parking capacity shall be reduced by no less than 25 percent.
- j. Sports field lighting shall remain off.
- k. The Trails & Tails Dog park is open subject to the requirements contained in the New Normal Guide and Miami-Dade County Emergency Orders for Dog Parks. Dogs can be off their leash in off leash dog areas of the park.
- I. Bike Racks will be accessible to the public.
- m. Use of the following amenities is prohibited:
  - a. Playgrounds and exercise equipment
  - b. Picnic shelters
  - c. Splashpads; and
  - d. Mechanical attractions.
- n. Table games, picnics and parties are prohibited.

Section 2. Failure to comply. Failure to comply with this Order shall constitute a misdemeanor subject to fines and imprisonment punishable as provided in F.S. §§ 775.082 and 775.083.



The Emergency measures that have been ordered and promulgated above effective are extended through August 14th, 2020.
