EXTENTIONS OF DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Governor Ron Desantis signed Executive Order 20-51 in response to the anticipated danger from the public health threat of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 1.01, 3.04, and 6.05 of the City's Charter and Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, the City of Hallandale Beach to declared a State of Local Emergency on March 9, 2020.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes require that the duration of each state of emergency declared locally is limited to 7 days but may be extended, as necessary, in 7-day increments.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City of Hallandale Beach Florida:

Section 1. Extensions of the Declaration of Local Emergency. The Declared State of Emergency originally declared on March 9, 2020 is hereby extended for 7-days from the last date of execution below, to be executed only as necessary.
