

# CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER AND SUPPLEMENT PURSUANT TO DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

# Section 1. Declaration Supplemented.

In accordance with Section 11-5(e) of the City Code of Ordinances and Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, the Declaration of a State of Emergency within the City of Homestead, Florida, ("City"), dated March 17, 2020 is further supplemented pursuant to this Order.

# Section 2. Findings.

- (A) The detailed findings of Governor Desantis' Executive Order Numbers 20-52, 20-68, 20-82, and 20-83, 20-91 and 20-92 are hereby incorporated herein by reference.
- (B) The detailed findings of Miami-Dade County Mayor Gimenez, as contained in Executive Order Extending Declaration of Local State of Emergency, dated March 25, 2020, is hereby incorporated herein by reference.
- (C) The City issued an Executive Order and Supplement pursuant to Declaration of a State of Emergency on March 27, 2020, establishing a curfew from 10:00 pm to 5:00 am in the City (the "Curfew").
- (D) The City issued an Executive Order on May 29, 2020, terminating the Curfew effective 12:01 a.m., June 1, 2020.
- (E) Continuing the practice of regular hand washing, general sanitizing and social distancing according to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines will continue to decrease the threat of COVID-19 to the general population of the City.

## Section 3. Order Rescinded.

The City Executive Order, dated May 29, 2020 terminating the Curfew is hereby rescinded.

### Section 4. Curfew.

The Curfew imposed by the Executive Order issued by the City on March 27, 2020 shall remain in effect until terminated by subsequent Executive Order.

### Section 5. Effective Date.

This Order shall be effective as of 5:00 p.m. on May 31, 2020, and may be further supplemented from time to time in accordance with Article I, Section 11-5 of Chapter 11 of the City Code. This document shall be posted and distributed as provided by City Code Section 11-5(f).
