By virtue of the powers and duties vested in me as the Village Manager of the Village of Key Biscayne, Miami-Dade County, Florida, in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes, Chapter 9 of the Village Code, and Resolution No. 2019-55 of the Village of Key Biscayne Village Council adopting the Village's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and pursuant to the Village's Declaration of a State of Emergency issued at 4:20 p.m. March 13, 2020, I hereby find that it would serve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Key Biscayne to revise the currently in effect within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of Key Biscayne, which would help protect the public health by mitigating the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Accordingly, I hereby issue this order revising the curfew beginning Wednesday, May 20, 2020 and continuing until further notice to be in effect between the hours of 11:00 PM and 5:00 AM, within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of Key Biscayne. No person shall be outside in this area during the curfew hours either as a pedestrian or by means of a vehicle, unless such person is providing police, fire, or other governmental services, providing assistance expressly requested by police, fire, or governmental personnel, or participating in, going to, or returning from a place of work or occupation. No individual shall violate the terms of this Emergency Order, except upon direct authorization of the Village of Key Biscayne Police Department. Any violation of this Emergency Order shall be subject to fine, imprisonment, and/or closure of the establishment.
