**EMERGENCY ORDER 20-2**

By virtue of the powers and duties vested in me as the Village Manager of the Village of Key Biscayne, Miami-Dade County, Florida, in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes, Chapter 9 of the Village Code, Resolution No. 2019-55 of the Village of Key Biscayne Village Council adopting the Village's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and pursuant to the Village's Declaration of a State of Emergency issued at 4:20 p.m. March 13, 2020, I hereby find that it would further mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus and serve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Key Biscayne to declare closed and off limits the:

- (1) Public beaches within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of Key Biscayne, except for individuals walking or running, but not gathering, on the beaches; and
- (2) Playground within the Village Green.

The Village encourages residents to utilize the Village's walkways, bikeways, and other outdoor areas along the Rickenbacker Causeway.

Accordingly, I hereby issue this order declaring these areas closed and off limits effective **Wednesday, March 18, 2020 and continuing until further notice**. No person shall enter these areas, except upon authorization of the Village of Key Biscayne Police Department.
