**EMERGENCY ORDER 20-9**

Date: April/29/2020

By virtue of the powers and duties vested in me as the Village Manager of the Village of Key Biscayne, Miami-Dade County, Florida, in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes, Chapter 9 of the Village Code, and Resolution No. 2019-55 of the Village of Key Biscayne Village Council adopting the Village's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and pursuant to the Village's Declaration of a State of Emergency issued at 4:20 p.m. March 13, 2020, I hereby find that it would further mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus and serve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Key Biscayne to declare the following:

1. All parks and recreational facilities shall comply with Miami-Dade County Emergency Order 21-20, as may be amended from time to time, except as provided herein:
  - a. Village Green shall be limited to persons 65 years and older between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. Village Green shall be open to all other persons between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
  - b. Village Beach Park shall remain closed until the beaches within the Village open.
  - c. Calusa Park shall remain closed until Monday, June 1, 2020.
2. Village Emergency Order 20-2 is hereby terminated. Beaches within the Village shall open when Miami-Dade County opens Crandon Beach.
3. Conflicts. All emergency orders or parts of orders, in conflict with this Emergency Order, are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Accordingly, I hereby issue this Emergency Order applicable within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of Key Biscayne **beginning as of 11:59 p.m., on Wednesday, April 29, 2020 and continuing until further notice** unless extended by the Village Manager. No person shall violate the terms of this Emergency Order, except upon direct authorization of the Village of Key Biscayne Police Department. Any violation of this Emergency Order shall be subject to fine or arrest. This Emergency Order shall expire as provided herein. This Emergency Order may be cancelled earlier by action of the Village Manager.
