**-EXTENDING STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION  
&  
EMERGENCY AUTHORIZATION ORDER-**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statute §252.38(3), provides authority to political subdivisions, to declare and enact State of Local Emergency, thereby waiving certain procedures and formalities, which would otherwise be required of the political subdivision by State or local law; and

**WHEREAS**, A State of Emergency was declared by Governor Ron DeSantis of the State of Florida, Executive Order No. 20-52 5:52 PM, March 9, 2020, and Miami-Dade County executed a Declaration of Local State of Emergency effective 8:51 AM, March 12, 2020 following the discovery of the dangerous and highly contagious COVID 19 Virus; and

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 poses an imminent health peril to Miami Shores residents, especially the elderly and those with a compromised immune system; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Ordinance 2018-09, Section 8-1 of the Village Code, the Mayor is designated as authority to declare an emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the applicable laws and statutes of the State of Florida implemented in Executive Order 20-52 are hereby adopted and included in this declaration as appropriate to Miami Shores Village to ensure the Village is prepared and timely precautions are taken to protect the safety, health, and welfare of the residents of Miami Shores Village; and

**WHEREAS**, during the Tuesday, March 17, 2020 Village Council Meeting and pursuant to the Village Code, Chapter 8, the Village Council acting as the Miami Shores Village Emergency Management Council ratified the emergency actions of the Mayor and the Village Manager, and their emergency powers going forward.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, as Mayor of Miami Shores Village, I, Crystal Wagar, hereby extend a State of Emergency Declaration for Miami Shores Village pursuant to Florida Statutes §252.38, pursuant to Chapter 8, Article 1, Sec. 8-1 of the Miami Shores Village Code of Ordinances, titled Emergency Management and otherwise. Additionally, I elect to adopt extended orders issued by the State of Florida and Miami-Dade County emergency management agencies. The Village reserves any right, benefit, or assistance offered by the State in Executive Order Nos. 20-51 and 20-52, and reserves its right to waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the Village by law pertaining to the items listed in the executive order.

This state of emergency shall continue in effect for an additional seven (7) days, commencing on March 24, 2020, and may be extended as necessary in accordance with Florida Statutes § 252.38. The Mayor and the Village Manager may terminate this State of Local Emergency when they have jointly declared that it is no longer necessary

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER DECLARED** that the Village Manager and Chief of Police are jointly authorized to exercise all emergency powers provided §252.38(3)(a), *Florida Statutes*, including, but not limited to, the suspension of certain local law, rule, or order that would prevent, hinder, or delay any mitigation, response, or recovery action necessary to cope with this emergency in accordance with law.
