



Oakland Park State of Emergency Declaration COVID-19 – Coronavirus


March 11, 2020

On March 1, 2020, the Governor of Florida issued Executive Number Order 20-51- Establishes COVID-19 Response Protocol and Directs Pubic Health Emergency and on March 9, 2020, issued Executive Order Number 20-52, Emergency Management –COVID-19 Pubic Health Emergency.

On March 10, 2020, Broward County declared a State of Emergency providing COVID-19 constitutes a clear and present threat to the health and welfare of the people of Broward County.

The Mayor of the City of Oakland Park, subsequent to the ratification by the City Commission March 18, 2020, does hereby declare a state of emergency for the City of Oakland Park.
