A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY ISSUED BY THE VILLAGE MANAGER FOR THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC PURSUANT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 252.38(3)(a) Florida Statutes authorizes political subdivisions to declare and enact a State of Local Emergency for a period of up to seven (7) days, thereby waiving the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the political subdivision by law; and

WHEREAS, the coronavirus pandemic required extraordinary and immediate actions by the Village of Pinecrest in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager, pursuant to Section 12-55(a) of the Code of Ordinances, issued a Declaration of Local State of Emergency on March 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Section 12-55(b) of the Code of Ordinances requires Village Council confirmation of the Declaration of Local State of Emergency issued by the Village Manager no later than at the next regular Village Council meeting;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF PINECREST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village Council hereby confirms the attached Declaration of Local State of Emergency issued by the Village Manager on March 12, 2020.

<u>Section 2</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

VILLAGE OF PINECREST, FLORIDA DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Chapter 252.38(3)(a) Florida Statutes gives authority to political subdivisions to declare and enact a State of Local Emergency for a period of up to seven (7) days, thereby waiving the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the political subdivision by law; and

WHEREAS, the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic may require extraordinary and immediate actions by the Village of Pinecrest in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its residents;

THEREFORE, the Village Manager of the Village of Pinecrest, pursuant to Section 12-55 of the Code of Ordinances, hereby declares a State of Local Emergency that will continue for seven (7) days or if cancelled before that period of time. This Local State of Emergency includes ALL OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST.

Pursuant to this Declaration, the Village Manager shall take whatever prudent actions are necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community. This specifically includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. An order recalling Village of Pinecrest employees from vacation, canceling days off and mobilizing all personnel required for disaster response;
- 2. Suspension of normal leasing and bid procedures to procure space, structures or other items for disaster response as determined by the Village Manager;
- 3. Authorization to procure supplies, equipment and services without formal bidding procedures;
- 4. In the period before, or during and immediately after an event, an order imposing a general curfew applicable to the Village of Pinecrest as a whole or to geographical areas of the Village and during hours the Village Manager deems necessary, and from time to time, to modify hours the curfew will be in effect and what areas it applies to;
- 5. An order requiring any or all commercial establishments located in areas of eminent or actual danger to close and remain closed until further order;
- 6. An order requiring the closure of any or all bars, taverns, liquor stores, and other business establishments where alcoholic beverages are predominantly sold or otherwise dispensed -- provided that with respect to those business establishments which are not primarily devoted to the sales of alcoholic beverages, and in which such alcoholic beverages may be removed or made secure from seizure by the public, the portions thereof utilized for the sale of items other than alcoholic beverages may, at the discretion of the Village Manager, be allowed to remain open;
- 7. An order requiring the discontinuance of the sale, distribution or giving away of alcoholic beverages in any or all parts the Village of Pinecrest;

- 8. An order requiring the closure of any or all establishments where firearms and/or ammunitions are sold or otherwise dispensed -- provided that with respect to those business establishments which are not primarily devoted to the sale of firearms and/or ammunition, and in which such firearms or ammunition may be removed or made secure from possible seizure by the public, the portions thereof utilized for the sale of items other than firearms and ammunition may, at the discretion of the Village Manager, be allowed to remain open;
- 9. An order requiring the discontinuance of the sale, distribution or giving away of gasoline or other liquid flammable or combustible products in any container other than a gasoline tank properly attached to a gas powered vehicle;
- 10. An order closing to the public any or all public places including streets, alleys, public ways, schools, parks, and public buildings;
- 11. Such other orders as are immediately necessary for the protection of life and property -- provided, however that any such orders shall, at the earliest practicable time, be presented to the Village Council for ratification or confirmation in accordance with applicable law;
- 12. Orders prescribing penalties to prevent price gouging for all building supplies and basic life support supplies such as food and water;
- 13. Orders requesting the conservation of water supplies;
- 14. The Village Manager shall cause any proclamation ordered by the Village Council pursuant to the authority of applicable law to be delivered to all news media within Miami-Dade County and shall utilize whatever available means to give public notice of such proclamation.
