

## **PROCLAMATION**

### **A PROCLAMATION BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH RENEWING THE PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY IN POMPANO BEACH, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 4, 2020, Mayor Rex Hardin signed a Proclamation proclaiming a public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the crisis still exists and an extension is needed to extend the public health emergency in Pompano Beach for seven days from March 12 through March 19, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the undersigned is authorized to execute the extension pursuant to § 252.38 (3)(a)(5), F.S.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Pompano Beach finds and determines that it is necessary to ensure that preparations of the City will be adequate to deal with and recover from this disaster or emergency; now, therefore,

**BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH,  
FLORIDA, THAT:**

- (1) The above recitals are true.
- (2) A public health emergency continues to exist in the City of Pompano Beach, Florida.
- (3) COVID-19 is a serious threat and all persons within the City should take all precautionary measures to combat the virus as suggested by the CDC and all applicable state and federal agencies.
- (4) I continue with direction to City Management to implement any and all measures required to best protect the citizens of Pompano Beach and to work closely with all

applicable state and federal agencies to obtain all methods, products and equipment to accomplish these goals.
