
COVID-19 EMERGENCY DECLARATION SAFETY MASK AND FACE COVERING ORDER

DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY SAFETY MASK / FACE COVERING ORDER (Pursuant to COVID-19 State of Emergency – April 8, 2020)

City of West Park Order #2020-03

- WHEREAS, Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a global pandemic that spreads rapidly from person to person and may result in serious illness or death, is believed to spread by respiratory droplets that come from the mouth and nose and may even be spread by people who are asymptomatic by breathing, talking, laughing, coughing, and sneezing; and
- WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis signed Executive Order No. 20-52, thereby declaring a public health emergency in the State of Florida due to public health threat resulting from the spread of COVID-19; and
- **WHEREAS,** on March 10, 2020, Broward County Administrator Bertha Henry declared a state of emergency in Broward County; and
- **WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization (WHO) declared COVID-19 a global pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the City of West Park declared a State of Local Emergency; and
- WHEREAS, on March 28, 2020 the City of West Park issued Emergency Order 2020-02 ordering all residents to stay at home except when engaging in essential services; and
- WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") recently issued guidance that the general population should wear cloth face coverings to capture the respiratory droplets of asymptomatic people to slow the spread of COVID-19; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to §252.46, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to Section 12-25 of the City's Code of Ordinances, the Mayor has the authority to issue emergency orders with the force of law.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric H. Jones, Mayor of the City of West Park, Florida, pursuant to Sections 252.38(3) and 252.46, Florida Statutes and pursuant to Section 12-25 of the City's Code of Ordinances and all other applicable laws, promulgates the following Emergency Orders:

SECTION 1. All persons outside of their homes within the City of West Park are strongly encouraged to wear cloth masks or other cloth face coverings consistent with the current CDC and Florida Department of Health guidelines for personal protective equipment. For purposes of this Order, persons should not utilize N95 rated masks unless engaged in providing health care, police, fire, or emergency management services or other persons engaged in life/safety activities.

SECTION 2. This Order shall remain in place as long as the State of Local Emergency is in effect, as may be amended and extended.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Emergency Order may be enforced within the boundaries of the City of West Park by the City's law enforcement agency, as well as the City's Code Enforcement Officers.

SECTION 4. This Emergency Order is effective immediately.
